### The e.-d. book of UFO-forms

I helped to organize and make public the children's interactive picture book, "The e.-d. book of UFO-forms", where the viewer can repeatedly mark a box called "epsilon", to see the next upgraded models or related variations of an illustration of a chosen form of existing UFOs (plus their typical energy fields). Also, whenever they choose to, they can mark another box called "delta", which will show some other geometrical form or shape of actually existing UFOs, and then again repeatedly upgrade that type.

By combining the evolving chosen choices from these boxes, the reader will quicker learn about UFOs, because in following their own curiosity and pace of satisfied understanding, their brain will along the way try to compare the varying two chosen pictures.

The book's first sample picture shows a somewhat-elliptical circular UFO with a small dark center, surrounded by its much bigger orange-hued yellow energy field with its own fuzzy, gently moving contours.
