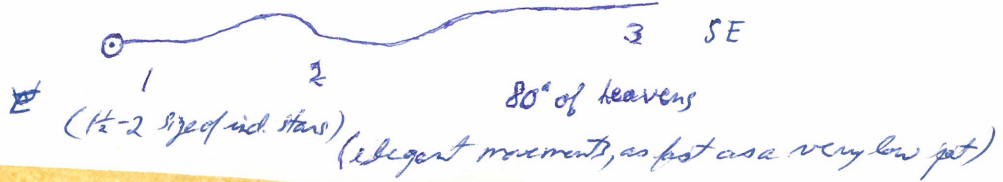


X Compared to jet movement later + today

Big Dipper

Condition: following back excursions often fatigued, mind strong + receptive.

- 1/2 - (6 lapses of a glowing white circle moving fast, seen out of back (W) window + only a small arc is blocked by roof)
- 1 - Ca. 4 minutes later, looking out of front window (E), after a few seconds + to my surprise, a white-powder-circle with black center, silently moving across the sky.
 - 2 - A wandering to the sides (like hesitating ^{deliberately} or hazardous movements), disappear in distance beyond horizon. (Because of unobtrusive movement + lighting, another might have assumed it to be a 'natural phenomena', but ^{recognition} went outside to look at stars 10 minutes, frustrated had seen only partly from ^{inside}.)

- Notes:
- a) Many times have thought in the moment that the viewing was routine + unimportant, but discovered after that new information was given!
 - b) Can see UFO's from an open window, but not enough visual realm to see whole event. (I. x. could not see if it was 'near' another object or not, so start or finish of flight course).
 - c) Feel timing exact show's connected to ind. viewer, but wandering movement into distance (following ^{and investigating} my ^{and up at it at some moments} angle at physical difficulty of looking, an experiment from (indoors) shows lack of interest or connection with my watching it.

Condition: a) Often emotionally aroused when see UFO's, 1st night Ken was leaving around Europe, another time after X-Mas¹⁹⁷⁵ successful, another anxious to have a close friend see as witness - psychic state unusually active. While seeking them, or using as a distraction from emot. worries does not produce sightings. Intellectual wandering fits with the less clear 1-2 second events.
