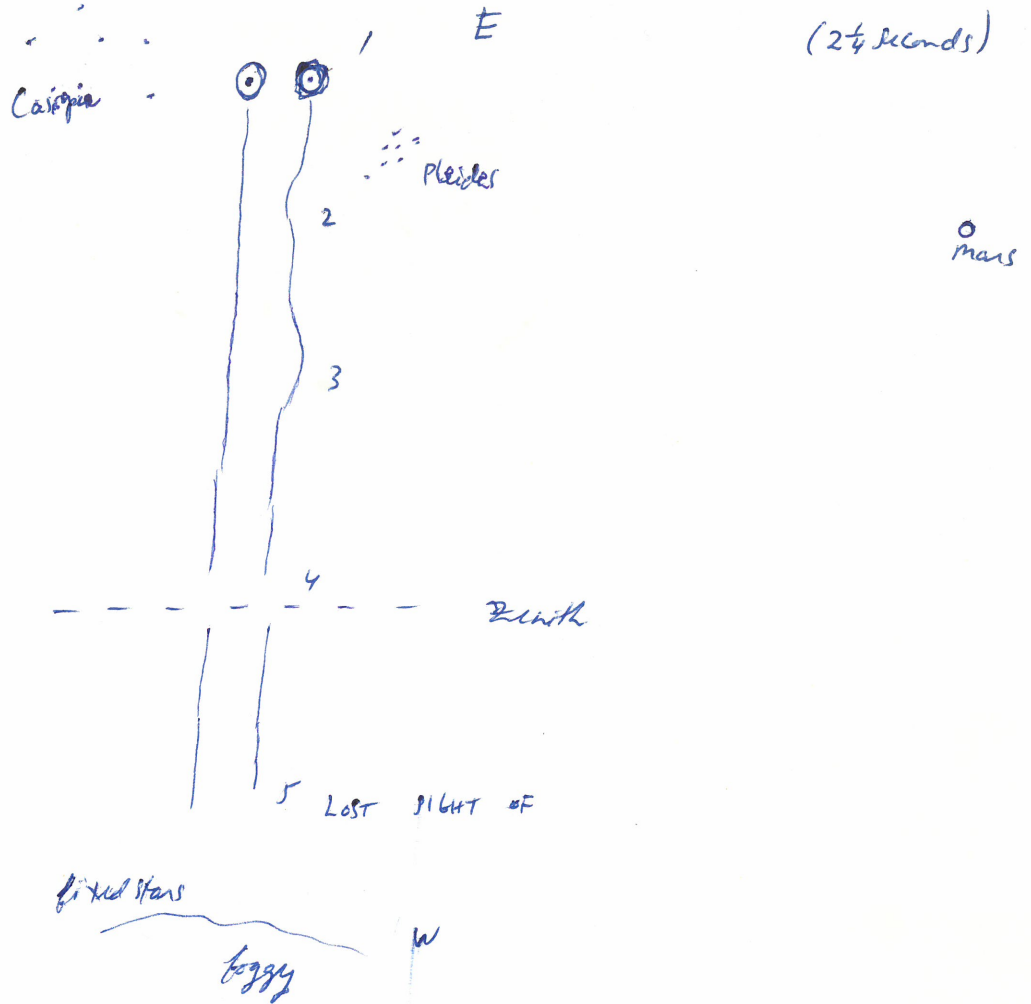


Note: recognized objects at once + pointed out, <sup>afterwards</sup> ~~large~~ less experienced see, would not note time (as many) details.

(2 1/4 seconds)



(First clear night in many days, watching stars on altar, neighbor writing there too.)

- 1 - Closer than 10/10, farther away than 12/10, two bright fuzzy-edged parallel white lights appear travelling relatively fast. A dome of white light on each side of elliptical-type circle, and a small black center. Enlarged.
- 2+3 - movement slightly in and out of at least one light (almost as if partly transparent light around outer parts of circle). (part of optical illusion because slight timing)
- 4 - Turn shoulder and body to see, continued course
- 5 - Lost sight of early, but neighbor said "still there" and then disappears in distance.

Sighting relatively vague because emotionally excited + talking, even having another see objects with me. Movement not too strange, neighbor's best description "they were moving in completely straight lines, 2 of them, white or pinkish, very fast"

Conditions: Expecting almost to see in the evening, because 1<sup>st</sup> clear night; impressed over exact timing (21<sup>00</sup>), TV had announced Mars is best visible around 21<sup>00</sup>; had been wondering about construction + movements, physics of machines.
