

My pet imagination about
the origins and purposes of UFOs
and about humanity's extended family

These thoughts take shape apart from what I observed:

Because the curvature of space-time makes good sense, UFOs could be coming from varying origins for various inclusive purposes.

Some of the more advanced civilizations from closer stars may have noticed the plight of humanity here, brazenly advertized by our many explosions of atomic bombs, and they might be sending out teams which are offering to help improve our progress by showing us some advanced technologies, which we could intelligently use to escape our recent suicidal course. They could also come from (for us) future, more developed races, compassionately trying to help their more primitive relatives to evolve and survive.

They would wisely not be outrightly gifting us with accomplished cures for our self-made problems, because if we don't ourselves deeply understand the involved mechanisms and have the collective will to actually create and maintain those solutions, we'd just slide back into the mire again.

During their visits, they also consistently demonstrate their own peaceful behaviour toward us, as a good example of the psychology of co-existence.

Some might be just anthropologically studying us, to see what we'll do in our self-caused recent planetary crisis.

Or maybe human-family type DNA has primordially spread from such distant planets by normal astronomical mechanisms.

Perhaps the potential DNA of human-like beings who live elsewhere is transported with dormant bacteria in the cosmic dust which is periodically slung out during the expulsion waves of a star-systems' and galaxy's old age - and later, parts of the dust clouds combine into falling asteroids in newly forming solar systems and galaxies, which seed the next ancestors of these species on life-sustaining planets of new stars.
