

What i progressively experienced/learned in succession
during the first 10 short sightings

Introductory event sometime between 2.10.75 and 15.10.75:

1. The 6 large consecutive, very white, star-shaped energy flashes were low in the air in the grassy area, which I cycled by.
2. There were very short pauses of varying lengths between them.
3. (Due to the contrast to the early morning darkness, they reminded me of "the unexplainable and other-worldly".)
4. The same size and type of flashes were seen in my later sightings of 28.12.75 and 27.4.76.

10.10.75-1:

1. I was emotionally elated because of an impending long-awaited meeting with a close relative. Having studied the UFO subject for a couple years and wanting to see one, they suddenly appeared to me unexpectedly.
2. They were at first near something lit, which was moving obviously in the sky, an airplane.
3. They lit-up in flight as somewhat elliptical circles of white light with a small dark center.
4. They initially flew in straight lines parallel to each other.
5. The one then sharply and abruptly changed directions in straight lines several times.
6. At one of its turns, it showed itself several times larger than before. (The new size implied that it had instantaneously dropped enormously in altitude. I later figured, it had also probably tilted over.)
7. During that section of its flight, the disk had a thin white arc along its one side, but its large area was filled by mostly curved, quickly rolling, red energy sections from the perimeter to its small center (shaped like curved grapefruit sections). These may have also been revolving around the center. (It reminded me of a braking movement, but at a constant speed.)
8. During that period its vector was straight toward the ground not far from me, and in shock I mentally asked it to not crash there!
9. Immediately after my thought, it changed directions (and possibly altitudes) back to flying parallel to the Earth again and was its former small shape.
10. I lost sight of it only because it flew off in the horizon.
11. The total sighting was only a few seconds.

10.10.75-2:

1. Both objects were the same smaller size as in the earlier sighting that night.
2. Their paths were perfectly coordinated, and they could make all manner of fast, curved flight-variations together during their generally straight flight across the sky.

3. They flew far across the sky in a general parallel direction, but mostly the one often wove in quick curves over the other's path and back out again to their standard distance. Once their paths curved away from each other, then quickly returned again, and twice they changed sides in relation to each other. (Reminded me of fishes playing as they swim next to each other.)

12.10.75:

1. I was both elated from my brother's impending visit plus the UFO sightings of two days earlier.

2. This was in a populated area, with only a small portion of the open sky visible in that place, and the 4 objects were much closer to me in the sky than at the earlier sightings (except when the "almost crashing" one had come equally close to me).

3. Each object had a black center with a loosely circular, internally-moving energy field around it, which was a little bigger than the UFO's tilted side in my first 10.10.75 sighting.

4. Another outer, loosely contoured energy-field around each object was constantly connected along one side with the corresponding field of its partner, during their parallel but curving flight-path together.

5. The two pairs of these large objects flew their separate curved courses in the same general direction, at a loose and varying, but still fairly close distance to the other pair. (The fast, moving curves made this seem playful to me, by our human bodily movement standards.)

6. (I had the impression that they were floating on a stream of white current which was both immediately in front of and behind each pair.)

7. The whole event was only 1 and 1/4 seconds, yet I could register the details.

4.11.75:

1. TV had announced that Mars would be most visible at 9 PM, and they appeared exactly at that time, with Mars in the same visual field to the far right.

2. My interested next-door neighbor witnessed this event with me on my outdoor terrace.

3. I recognized the UFOs at once by their typical somewhat elliptical fuzzy shape, and their standard soft shade of white. Also by their dark center and beginning parallel flight.

4. Each had a sliver of a well-defined white arc outside its right side, which hinted at that side having height.

5. The one moved slightly in and out of its otherwise straight path, while the other flew straight across the sky.

Sometime between 20.10.75 and 17.12.75:

1. On my outdoor terrace, I had just finished a long meditation, in which I had been internally distracted during some sections, but mostly quite concentrated.

2. I was very familiar with star constellations and the planets. When at the end, I opened my eyes, the Big Dipper ("Karlsvognen") was clearly high up in front of me, but with a star equally as bright, white, and large as the constellation's other main stars, halfway in between its two bottom stars.

3. I realized no bright star or planet should be there, and a couple seconds later, it flew away in a fast, relaxed, upward curve for several seconds, before disappearing in the distance.

4. (This was the first time that I realized the UFO-beings had been either studying my consciousness-states during meditation, just as I studied how they worked, or were just greeting me obviously, underlining that our relationship was inter-active.)

8.12.75:

1. This was in early morning light, with Venus bright and an airplane obvious elsewhere in the sky.

2. From nothing visible, it lit up very brightly, standing still in the air.

3. The shape, larger than a star, was triangular with rounded sides.

4. It flew slowly (almost like floating) into a small cloud and never came out again.

17.12.75:

1. The large, shining, fuzzy-white light was clearly formed like half a donut, with its axis tipped clockwise. The small area where the center normally is, was missing, invisible, or transparent.

2. It was either the side, top, or bottom view of most of a UFO in oblique downwards flight.

3. It suddenly faded totally out.

4. (My sightings always happen shortly after I start intensively looking at the sky, and never when I'm concentratedly looking for one while curious to learn more.)

5. (They often happen in locations where I feel comfortable and confident.)

6. (Usually no one else is looking that way, or is around, which convinces me this is a private contact from their side.)

7. (The short sightings cause a small shock, which leaves me questioning and puzzled, wanting to know more.)

8. (After wondering about a certain area of details or their mechanisms for several days, the next sightings often reveal more details in that area.)

28.12.75:

1. A UFO can be orange (as if glowing or partially transparent), semi-circular, around 5 meters wide, and demonstrably very close-by.

2. It can have a small, briefly darkened rectangular segment, indented in the semi-circle's side or off-centered on its bottom rim.

3. The UFO can be almost on or perhaps on the ground.

4. The large energy-sparks in the air must be related to the high-voltage electricity

which is relayed through the cables from the mast.

5. The darkened section can be lit up again, so that it fits in seamlessly with the rest of the semi-circle.

6. A clumsy child-sized being dressed in a black suit may have been left behind for a period, after the UFO has disappeared.

7. (Maybe the UFO had malfunctioned and needed to "tank up" from the mast, and left in haste because I got too close with my barking, scared dog, leaving someone behind, who was picked up later.)

4.1.76:

1. From my window's blocked view, I saw a UFO in flight across the small visible arc of sky, and 4 minutes later, saw one again from a window on the opposite side of the house. After that, as freely viewed outdoors, a UFO flew at a third speed and apparently higher altitude fully across the sky. All in the same direction.

2. Irritated at my acute neck-pain from bending back to follow its overhead course, I cursed toward it, and then it veered to both sides awhile, before continuing its straight flight.

3. (The repetitive exact timing of such sightings when one's alone, shows that they're somehow coordinated with the individual viewer's exact location and where they're looking.)

4. (If the UFO's veering was a direct reaction to my abrupt anger, it's both sensitive to and self-protective against the viewer's aggressive outbreaks.)
