Dec.17, 1975

## Description:

On Dec. 17, 1975, at 10:44 PM, while looking at the stars, the full moon and Jupiter to the right, the Fixed stars clear and Gemini high up before me, I saw a large, shining white light appear at about 30 degrees left of my central vision. It was flying fast toward the right, and I recognized its soft, fuzzy white light as the special kind of light or energy typical of the earlier seen UFOs.

It was shaped like 1/2 to 2/3 of a donut, tilted at 45 degrees: that is, it was tilted, almost a semi-circle, and with a much smaller - missing, invisible, or transparent - nearly semi-circle in the middle of its broken base-line. I could see the background sky and clouds around the object and through its central semi-circular area. The outline around its edges was clear but blurry.

Judging from the shapes of UFOs in my earlier sightings, it could have been either the side-view of a UFO, minus a small central area, and flying with its straight base in front - or the circular top/bottom view of a UFO, with both one nearly semi-circular side and its total center somehow visually missing, and flying obliquely downwards.

This whole complex light suddenly faded totally out.

Total time, 1 second at the most.

Subjective after-thoughts:

- a) The sightings always happen shortly after I begin to look at the sky intensively, and never yet when concentrating on seeing a UFO out of curiosity.
- e) Sometimes I feel beforehand that I'll see an event the particular evening, and do so (but pretty often I feel this, yet see nothing).
- b) They're usually in places where I feel personally confident, often while standing alone next to my house.
- d) Usually, no one else sees them, because even when walking nearby, they often don't look upwards this may be a private contact.
- c) My first sightings were both detailed and relatively long, while the next sightings were only 1-2 seconds, leaving me questioning and not satisfied.
- f) Each sighting shows different details, often appearing soon after I'd been thinking about that area of details for several days.

Possible hypotheses to explain the so-far experienced phenomena and their

pre-conditions. These UFO sightings might be:

- 1) To consciously get my attention, to add to the number of positively-attuned, fast-thinking, easily formulating, concentrated and focused witnesses, who will then document the UFOs' precise behaviour for other people.
- 2) Replying to the observer's earnest invitation, or to their questions and thoughts about UFOs' details and mechanisms.
- 3) To puzzle or stimulate me more than to answer me.
- 4) In many cases, it might be chance who sees the UFOs, but short individual sightings could be more pointedly purposeful.
- 5) When I start to dwell on a section of the stars, my mental energy flies through space there, and intelligent energy-forms near my line of vision may register that current.
- 6) Maybe there's two kinds of visual currents or bands: a broad one which transports through long distances, and a more narrow one for closer, almost instantaneous, non-verbal communication, within the narrow area of sky someone's looking at.
