

Dec.28, 1975

Description:

On Dec. 28, 1975, at 8:30 PM, a foggy, very dark night, while walking the dog, I saw for a split-second out of the corner of my eye, near the base of the high, ultra-powerful electricity mast in the nearby muddy field, a large semi-circled shape with a light-fuzzy orange color as if it was both glowing and transparent, but having a darkened small rectangular section next to its edge – like either an indented side-portal or an off-centered door-space (creating almost the same shape as the previous Dec. 17th sighting) - and then it was gone at once.

When I recognize a UFO and there's time, I usually make the "namaste" sign of joined hands before my heart and throat (meaning "peace to you, related brother, or respected teacher") - which I also did now.

It was dark as we slowly crossed the field, my dog pulling and barking. At 100-150 meters distance to the place, about 1 minute later, four bright lights (like energy stars or huge firecracker sparks) silently consecutively flashed in the air near the pole, vertically one after the other from the top one and down, then darkness again.

About 1 minute later, the same large orange shape, this time as a uniformly lit half circle with no door or window area, silently hovered in the air about half-way up the pole. I saw it completely and clearly, and then it totally disappeared.

Total combined time of these sightings was about 5 seconds.

Immediately afterwards, a child-sized being in a black "body-suit" from head to foot ran clumsily but very fast from the site, rather far across the muddy field toward the nearby low semi-detached houses, where I followed and looked for it for several minutes, but I'd lost it.

By comparing the UFO's width to the distance between the mast's two slanted feet, I estimated its diameter to be about 5 meters (16 feet).

Subjective after-thoughts:

I wondered what the connection was between the energy-sparks, the high-voltage electricity at the mast, and the UFO's close proximity to it. I wondered if my dog's nervous, somewhat aggressive reactions made us less welcome as we came closer.

Follow up: I asked in two firecracker stores if such a light phenomenon as this

orange one could be noiselessly made by any type of firecracker. Neither knew of this sort of pattern or explosion, and both ruled out that it could happen silently.
